
3. Bidding will be conducted through the **National Competitive Bidding process** as specified in the Public Procurement & Concessions Commission Act (PPCA) of 2010.

  - ❖ **Letter of Certification from at least three (3) previous clients.; and**
  - ❖ **PPCC vendors registry certificate**


